Relative to the aim of the Indigenous Peoples Education Program which is to ensure the development and utilization of contextualized lesson plans and learning resources, the Schools Division of Tabuk City is conducting a Search for the Most Sustained and Functional School IPED Learning Resource Center.

The search is open to all elementary and secondary schools in the division. There shall be four categories for both the elementary and secondary schools. Small schools are those with lone teacher up to six (6) teachers. Medium schools are those with seven (7) to twelve (12) teachers. Big schools are those with thirteen (13) to twenty-five (25) teachers and mega schools are those with twenty-six (26) or more teachers.

There shall only be one (1) Most Sustained and Functional IPED learning Resource Center to be declared under each category. All the other participating schools will be finalists. There will be three schedules of monitoring and evaluation of the IPED LR Centers. The first schedule will be on April, 2020. The second round of M & E will be on July, 2020, and the last round will be on October, 2020.

Only the schools with approved project proposals can join the search. All proposals should have been submitted on or before February 14, 2020. The proposal should include the following parts:

1. Development of Contextualized Learning Packages 45%

a. Developed Contextualized Lesson Logs and Learning Resources (Quality-assured by School QA Team) 10%

b. Developed Contextualized Lesson Log and Learning Resources (Quality-assured by Division QA Team) 15%

c. Developed Contextualized Lesson Log and Learning Resources (Quality-assured by Regional OA Team) 20%

- 2. Structure (Room or any structure in the school which serves as the center), Presence of variety of artifacts/ Indigenous Peoples Material culture properly labeled, and proper arrangement and organization of all materials in the IPED LR Center 25%
- 3. Functionality of the IPED LR Center/ Utilization of the Contextualized Learning Packages and the displayed artifacts (with evidences of functionality) 30%
 - a. Log book
 - b. Borrower's slips
 - c. Pictorials
 - d. Advocacy Materials
 - e. Evidences of consultation with the Elders
