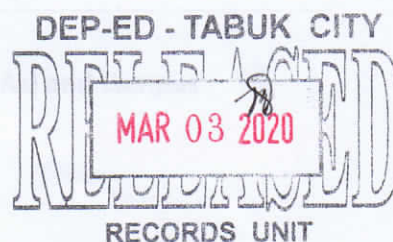

SUBJECT: **Tabuk City Division Participation to the 2020 National Schools Press Conference**
