 to deliver instruction in a safe work and learning environment amid the threat of
 COVID-19, the Division of Tabuk City through the Curriculum Implementation
 Division will conduct the Division Training-Workshop on Radio Broadcasting and
 Script writing on July 27-31, 2020.
- The training-workshop aims to:
 - a. Understand the radio as a medium for instruction;
