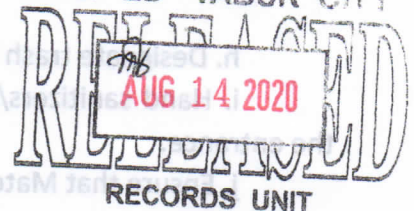

SUBJECT: **REITERATION OF THE COMPLIANCE TO MINIMUM HEALTH STANDARDS IN SCHOOLS**

1. The Department of Education is committed to ensure safe educational continuity amidst the challenges of COVID-19.
2. In the provision of learning opportunities, the health and safety of our learners and teaching and non-teaching personnel are of utmost importance and must be protected at all times.
3. To ensure the safe return to schools when allowed by DOH, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, the Office of the President, DepEd issues the enclosed Guidelines on the Required Health Standards in Basic Education Offices and Schools for the guidance of all learners, teachers, and nonteaching personnel nationwide.
4. These specific measures should be observed upon entering and while in the school premises based on DepEd Order 014 s. 2020:
 - a. Practice physical distancing atleast one meter apart at all times.
 - b. Frequent handwashing with soap and water.
 - c. When sneezing/ coughing, use tissue or inner portion of elbow to cover nose and mouth.
 - d. Observe proper use of face masks at all times. Both mouth and nose must be covered.
 - e. Temperature checking using thermal scanner prior to entering the school.
 - f. Foot baths in all entrances.
 - g. Toilets with adequate water and soap





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- h. Designate trash bins for tissue disposal
 - i. Hand sanitizers/ alcohol-based solutions/ other disinfectants in all rooms and at the entrance.
 - j. Ensure that Material Recovery Facility (MRF) is set up for proper waste segregation.
5. All schools are requested to put health signages as follows::
- a. "No face mask, no entry"
 - b. "Physical distancing of one meter apart"
 - c. "Frequent hand-washing with soap and water"
 - d. "Observe proper coughing & sneezing etiquette"
6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this memorandum are directed.
