**STRENGTHENING SCHOOL-BASED MANAGEMENT (SBM) IN DEPED CAR
UNDER THE NEW NORMAL**

1. With Reference to Regional Memorandum no. 155, s. 2021 released today pursuant to RA 9155 or the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2021 and DepEd Order 83, s. 2021, re: Implementing Guidelines on the Revised School Based Management Framework, Assessment Process and Tool (APAT), and the Regional Memorandum No. 278, s. 2029, re: Guidelines on the Utilization of School Based Management Assessment Tool with Contextualized Means of Verification, and the conducted SBM validations in the Cordillera Administrative Region for the past three years, the Regional Office's findings warrant a need for strengthening the principles of the school system.
2. The webinar aims to reiterate the objectives of the RM 278 as follows:
 - a) To highlight Cordillera Learners as center of the SBM practice
 - b) To encompass the diverse realities of learning context defined and uniquely occurring within specific geographic, social, cultural, economic and environmental make-up of the contemporary society
 - c) To enhance commitment of education stakeholders at all levels to their responsibilities and accountability in realizing education outcomes for Cordillera learners
 - d) To promote shared governance between the school and community
 - e) To integrate accreditation into SBM for a seamless assessment of school system
 - f) To improve the school system's capacity to be on track in achieving the sustainable Millennium Goals and performance
3. The webinar on April 19-21, 2021 from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM will use the Microsoft Teams platform for online participants from Tabuk City and other divisions. Enclosed is the list of the 18 participants from DepEd Tabuk City.
