- All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads To All PSDSs All Others Concerned
- As per meeting during the Regional Management Committee Meeting at Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet, only 50% of the total number of endorsed in each school are 1. allowed to use printed learning modules and the other 50% use other modalities like hand held radio, offline e-learning, etc.
- Schools are therefore encouraged to find other modalities to use, other than printed 2. SLMs. Printed SLMs is being discouraged due to its negative environmental impact and since it will only be used once then disposed. Therefore, other more sustainable modalities are being encouraged.
