## SEARCH FOR THE BEST INTEGRATION OF FINANCIAL LITERACY KEY CONCEPTS IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THROUGH SELF-LEARNING MODULES

- 1. Pursuant to RM No. 606 s. 2021, SDO Tabuk City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division will be conducting Search for the Best Integration of Financial Literacy Key Concepts in Science and Mathematics Through Self-Learning Modules.
- 2. The search is an SLM writing for teachers on developing creative and innovative SLMs that best integrate financial literacy concepts such as budgeting, saving, investing and among others through the connection of learning content in Math and Science. The SLMs must be MELC based and the coverage of the lessons will be anywhere from first to fourth quarter of Grade 4 to 6 for Elementary and Grades 7 to 10 for JHS. This is open to all Grade 4 to 6 Math and Science teachers in Elementary and in Grades 7 to 10 Math and Science teachers in Junior High School in both public and private schools. The category of the search are as follows:
  - a. Best SLMs in Mathematics Elementary
  - b. Best SLMs in Mathematics Junior High School
  - c. Best SLMs in Science Elementary
  - d. Best SLMs in Science Junior High School
- 4. Each district shall identify the best SLMs in each category in their respective district and shall be submitted to the division on or before January 10, 2022. A hard copy shall be submitted to the records section and the soft copy will be submitted to the following email addresses. <a href="mailto:cresencia.naoy@deped.gov.ph">cresencia.naoy@deped.gov.ph</a> for Science and <a href="mailto:emmanuel.ubuan@deped.gov.ph">emmanuel.ubuan@deped.gov.ph</a> for Mathematics. The identified best Self-Learning Modules in each category shall be the Division entry to the Regional level.

# SEARCH FOR THE BEST INTEGRAION OF FINANCIAL LITERACY KEY CONCEPTS IN SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS THROUGH SELF-LEARNING MODULES

## **Competition Mechanics**

- 1. The competition is open to all public and private elementary and junior high school Science and Math teachers. There shall be four (4) categories:
  - a. SLMs in Mathematics for Elementary
  - b. SLMs in Mathematics for Junior High School
  - c. SLMs in Science for Elementary
  - d. SLMs in Science for Junior High School
- 2. The SLMs must be aligned with the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) in Science or Mathematics of the K to 12 Curriculum. The coverage of the lessons will be anywhere from first to fourth quarter of Grade 4 to Grade 6 for Elementary and Grade 7 to Grade 10 for the Junior High School.
- 3. The SLMs may also include the financial literacy training videos by BDO Foundation Inc. which is made available through the DepEd Portal.
- 4. Entries should be written in English being the medium of instruction of the learning area.
- 5. Maximum of tw0 (2) teachers may collaborate on the SLM. Teacher- participants must be teaching Math or Science for at least three (3) years. In addition, teacher-writers for the Junior High School level should have a specialization in Science or Math or is a graduate of Math/Science related courses.
- All entries must be received not later than January 10,2021 at the Division Office. Entries
  received after the deadline will no longer be evaluated. Files must be saved in PDF version
  following this filename format: SLM\_Level\_Learning Area\_School\_LASTNAME, e.g.
  SLM\_Elementary\_Math\_Laya IS\_UBUAN
- 7. An entry found to be copied or imitated will mean disqualification from the competition. Intellectual Property of the submitted SLMs shall be owned by the proponent/s. permission will be given to DepEd to allow reproduction of the SLMs at no cost to DepEd regardless of the number of copies perpetually for future use by the other teachers.

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There will be a separate set of evaluators/judges for each category. A separate guideline
on the process of evaluating judging the entries shall be issued for the judges. The SLMs
will be evaluated based on the agreed set of criteria.

Should permission for use of third party content be necessary, the party submitting the SLM shall secure such permission in writing. In all cases, any and all consequences of the use of any third party content, including any criminal, civil or administrative liability that may result from unauthorized or unlawful use thereof, shall be the sole responsibility of the party submitting the SLMs which contain such third party content.

## 2. Documentary Requirements

Together with the submission of the digital copies of the SLMs, the following shall also be submitted in digital copies as necessary documentary requirements:

- 2.1 Duly accomplished Submission Form in digital format (Word File) for each set (per grade level, learning area, and quarter) of SLMs. Please see Anaex 1 for the template of the Submission Form.
- 2.2 A certified true copy of NBDB Registration or Business Registration/Permit from the local government unit must be submitted by private entities.

## C. Technical Requirements of the SLMs

The following are the technical requirements for the submission of SLMs:

#### 1. Instructional Design




Figure 2. Instructional Design (Source: BLD, Oct. 11, 2020)

The Instructional Design (ID) is the systematic framework used in designing printed learning resources. It translates the principles of teaching and learning into place for teaching-learning strategies, developmental activities, and evaluative measures that complement the contents. Figure 2 describes the Instructional Design for Q3 and Q4 SLMs which follows the Input-Output-Process.





## Self-learning Modules Instructional Design

#### Curriculum

The Quarters 3 and 4 SLMs to be submitted shall be anchored on the MELCs which can be accessed and downloaded by interested parties from htttp://lrmds.deped.gov.ph/detail/18275 https://commons.deped.gov.ph/MELCS-Gudelines.pdf.

#### Elements per Lesson

This section deals with the elements culled from the ID and describes the guidelines for development of SLMs. However, private and public entities may consider other terms provided that these are synonymous, essential, and consistent in the achievement of learning objectives and presentation in the inside pages.

#### a. Overview

contains an Introduction that discusses the topic/content of the module and the learning objective/s

#### **Objectives**

- anchored on MELCs
- inform the learners of the expected outcomes

#### Pre-assessment

check the learner's knowledge about the lessons

#### Prior-knowledge

facilitate condition of learning

#### b. Presentation

#### Concept Development

- sufficiently develop the MELCs intended for the learning area and grade level
- logically developed and organized
- suitable to the learner's level of development, needs, experience, and context
- free from any type of error
- · cognizant of intellectual property rights





#### Activities

· developmental and age appropriate

#### Assessments

- · aligned with the objectives and content
- · varied and involve self-check exercises
- · contain answer keys for objective type of questions

#### c. Application

 differentiated tasks based on the learner's multiple intelligences, learning styles, and readiness level

## Design and Layout

- Contain enough space between words, between lines, and between texts and visuals
- Citations for graphics and visuals shall be on the same page
- Page endings do not end with a hyphenated word or an awkward page turn which affect readability
- Adequate illustrations in relation to text
- Harmonious blending of clements (e.g., illustrations and text)
- Properly laid out and sustain readability

### Typeface and Font Size

- Appropriate for the target user
- Easy to read to enable the target users to easily identify themes and ideas
