REITERATION ON THE UPDATED COVID-19 PROTOCOL

- 1. This is to update the Covid -19 protocols based on the DOH guidelines as of January 14, 2022.
- 2. Those fully vaccinated who were tested positive who are asymptomatic or mild cases will be isolated for 7 days while partially vaccinated or unvaccinated personnel will quarantine for 10 days from date of test.
- 3. Those positive moderate cases will be isolated for 10 days from onset of symptoms regardless of vaccination status.
- 4. Positive severe and critical case regardless of vaccination status will be isolated for 21 days from onset of symptoms.
- 5. Those asymptomatic close contacts who are fully vaccinated will be isolated for 5 days from exposure while those with incomplete vaccination or unvaccinated will quarantine for 14 days or undergo swab test.
- 6. However, the number of quarantine days will be dependent on the quarantine facility for those who were admitted or BHERTS of the barangay for those on home quarantine.
- 7. Vaccinated individuals who are close contacts that are symptomatic are required to submit themselves for swab test or isolate themselves for 7 days from onset of symptoms.
- 8. Those partially vaccinated or unvaccinated close contacts that are symptomatic will isolate themselves for 10 days from onset of symptoms.
