**UPDATING THE DIRECTORY OF YOUTH PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES  
AND ORGANIZATIONS' FOCAL PERSONS OF YES-O, BSP, GSP, AND SPORTS**

1. The Department of Education Youth Formation Division aims to develop the country's youth for societal growth by fulfilling the department's thrusts to produce learners imbued with the values **maka-Diyos, maka-Tao, maka-Kalikasan, and maka-Bansa**, enabling them to become highly-skilled individuals who are responsible, hardworking, enterprising, persevering, value-driven, and culturally-rooted, hence the SDO Tabuk City through the Schools Governance and Operations Division ensures the effective and efficient implementation of special/ regular PAPS and organizations which are aligned to the learners' co-curricular and extra-curricular development needs under or relative to flagship programs of the SSG and SPG.
2. The Schools Division Office hereby directs all schools to ensure the existence of the YES-O, BSP and GSP organizations and Sports Program in schools based on voluntary participation principle for the following purposes:
  - a. to support the implementation of the K to 12 Curriculum by honing and complementing the societal engagement, technical skills, social skills, creativity and innovation skills, affective skills, and self-mastery skills; and
  - b. to serve as an avenue for performance tasks as aligned to the principle of differentiated instruction, and Gender and Development Programs whenever deemed appropriate
  - c. to support the SIP/AIP PAPS implementation in the schools

3. The schools are directed to designate focal persons (adviser/coordinator) of the aforementioned organizations and programs if they have not yet done so in School-Year 2021-2022 through issuance of designation orders.
4. Likewise, all Public Schools District Supervisors are to designate District Sports Coordinators.
5. After which, school heads and PSDSs are required to update the Schools Division PAPS Directory by providing the names and contact information of the focal persons through the link <https://bit.ly/focalsTabuk> not later than March 30, 2022. This information shall be used by the Division Program Focal Persons to assist the designated focal persons in the simplification of PAPS implementation as appropriate and doable in the present School-Year.
