- 1. In line with DepEd Memorandum no. 63, s. 2022 titled "2022 Oplan Balik Eskwela" all public schools are directed to ensure the following indicators before August 22, 2022:
 - 1.1 100% compliance to all indicators in the OBE monitoring tool before August 2022:
 - 1.2 Teachers' Daily Lesson Logs (DLL) for the first week of classes are duly reviewed:
 - 1.3 Temporary SF1 and SF2 are ready for each of the organized classes;
 - 1.4 Awareness of the Enrollment Committee that they are expected to usher enrollees to their classrooms upon filling out enrollment form during the first day of classes:
 - 1.5 Readiness of teachers to conduct debriefing and class orientation as psychosocial support service during the first day of classes; and
 - 1.6 Presence of contingency plan for all possible untoward incidences (i.e. COVID infections)
- 2. Conduct of parents' orientation on or before August 26 is a must to debrief and inform them of the basic education delivery mode, other class-related matters, and their roles for the success of this school year.
- 3. All District Monitoring Team members (PSDSs, EPSs, SGOD in charge, and ADASs) shall conduct follow-up OBE monitoring during the first week of classes and provide technical assistance if needed.
