Conduct of Multi-Factored Assessment to Grade 1

- 1. The Division Office through the Curriculum and Implementation Division would like to remind the field on the conduct of assessment to Grade 1 learners manifesting developmental delay using the Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT). This is a onetime assessment administered to Grade I learners enrolled in the regular schools who may exhibit developmental advancement or delays or with manifestations of learning disability. The MFAT is a screening tool intended to gather information on learner's strengths, needs, learning styles, and other educational concerns. It also aims to assist teachers for instructional planning and educational placement of learners.
- 2. The activity shall be conducted in all schools a month after the beginning of each school year by the trained teacher on the use of MFAT which shall commence this September 22, 2022.
- 3. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
