REITERATION OF NO CLASS DISRUPTION POLICY

CID and SGOD Chiefs To: **Public Schools District Supervisors**

Public and Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Other Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel

- 1. This is to reiterate DepEd Order 34, s. 2022 re school calendar and activities providing that 203 class days shall be for academic hours for the School Year 2022-2023 and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 on instituting measures to increase engaged time-on-tasks, and shall not cause any class disruptions.
- 2. Extra-curricular activities like drum and lyre practices, sports competition and other related activities should be conducted after class hours, weekends or holidays with strict observance of the department's communication order, and safety protocols.
- 3. Should unavoidable and crucial event warrant a schedule adjustment, a request by the concerned school head to the Schools Division Superintendent through the PSDS should be made one week prior to the event.
