- The Schools Division of Tabuk City through the Curriculum Implementation will conduct a Specialized Training for Grades IV-VI MAPEH Teachers to be scheduled on weekends due to DepEd Order No.34 s.2022 stating that schools shall strictly devote ten (10) weeks of every academic quarter to actual classroom teaching.
