- Pursuant to Regional Memorandum Nos. 57 and 152 s., 2023), the 2023 Regional Schools
 Press Conference will be held in Baguio City on April 28 to May 1, 2023 with the theme"
 Pagkakaisa't Pagbubuklod Tungo sa Matatag, Maginhawa, Panatag at Makabatang Bansa."
- 2. The conference aims to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the importance of journalism by expressing it through varied journalistic endeavors and approaches;
 - b. sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
 - c. provide a venue for enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
 - d. promote responsible journalism and fair use of social media; and,
 - e. enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 3. In line with this, the Schools Division of Tabuk City will participate in the prestigious event particularly those campus journalists who won 1st and 2nd Place in the Individual Events, 1st place in the Group Contests and top 5 in the School Paper Category, the respective coaches of all events, Outstanding SPA Adviser and Campus Journalist, School Paper Advisers, Technical Working Group, EPSs in English and Filipino and the Chief Education Supervisor. Attached Encl 1 on the list of RSPC Qualifiers and coaches.
- 4. The conference includes the following activities in two levels: elementary and secondary, and of two media: English and Filipino:
 - A. Individual Contests;
 - B. School Paper Contest;
 - C. Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting Contest;
 - D. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting Contests (for secondary level);
 - E. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (CDP) Contest;

- G. Concurrent Sessions
- H. Awarding of the Winners, the Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs), and Campus Journalists (CJs) among others.
- 5. School paper entries per section/level/media and the supporting documents of candidates for the Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists shall be submitted to the Division Office on or before April 14, 2023 1:00 pm. All RSPC participants shall submit their school paper (print or PDF copy) as a mandatory requirement of the RO on or before April 21, 2023.
- 6. A total amount of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP 2,000) shall be collected from each participant to cover the registration fee of two hundred pesos (PhP 200) and an amount of One thousand eight hundred pesos (PhP 1,800) for the 12 meals in the duration of the contest, charged against school local funds/journalism funds/ canteen funds or any available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies/rules and regulations. The CLGU provides the travelling expenses of the delegation.
- 7. A three (3) day compensatory overtime credit or compensatory time-offs (COCs/CTO) shall be granted the to the coaches and Technical Working Group (TWG) composed of teaching and 4.5 for non-teaching personnel in lieu of April 29,30 and May 1, 2023 Saturday, Sunday and holiday.
