IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS COMPONENTS FOR SY 2023-2024

- Pursuant to Republic Act 11037 or the "Masustansyang Pagkain Para sa Batang Pilipino Act" and DepEd Order No 31, s 2021 entitled "Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP), the School Governance and Operation Division(SGOD) - School Health and Nutrition Unit(SHNU) shall facilitate the implementation of the SBFP Nutritious Food Products targeted Kinder to Grade 6 severely wasted(SW) and wasted (W)learners as beneficiaries.
- To ensure the continuity of the School-Based Feeding Program Nutritious Food Products implementation for one hundred fifteen (115) feeding days, it shall start on November 6, 2023 to actively support and participate in the preparation of the upcoming Regional IPED congress and finish the long holidays which will commence from the last week of October to first week of November by which learners will be on Alternative Delivery Mode(ADM) or modular learning.
- Relative to this, all elementary schools shall ensure the readiness to receive, handle store and distribute NFP component and accomplished other related activities for the successful implementation of the program.
