



- 3. Organized, formal entrances that involve organized cheers or run-ons with jumps, tumbling, or stunts are notpermitted. Cheerleaders, dancers and mascots should enter the performance area in a timely fashion.
- 4. Timing will begin with the first organized word, movement, or note of music by the team or individual after they areofficially announced.
- 5. Timing will end with the last organized word, movement, or note of music by the team or individual. Teams orindividuals must exit the performance area immediately following the routine.
- 6. Cheer teams should utilize all areas of their squad's technical strength in jumps, tumbling, partner stunts, pyramids,motion technique, projection and expression, choreography, showmanship, and dance.
- 7. Only the following props are allowed for cheer teams: flags, banners, megaphones, pom pons, and signs. Flagsand/or banners with poles or similar support apparatus may not be used in conjunction with a stunt or tumbling.
- 8. Team/individual names will be called twice: once as the team/individual on deck and once as the next team/squadto perform.
- 9. Routines must be appropriate for family viewing. Any vulgar or suggestive movements (hip thrusting, inappropriatetouching/slapping/positioning to one another, etc.), words, costuming or music will result in a .5 score deduction. Notear-away uniforms or removal of clothing is allowed
