- 5. Elementary and Secondary Public and Private Schools shall participate in their school intramurals, and other lower sports Meets.
- After the Dual and Triangular Meets, all Rank 1 delegation in each sport event in their respective mother districts shall be top seed in each bracket in the Division level.
- Schools must have sports club to be qualified to join from the district meet to the next level of competition. They are encouraged to participate only in sports events in which they can confidently compete.
- 8. Schools which do not have or already have a sports club but haven't yet registered through the SSEEDP link, need to do so at https://bit.ly/afterschoolsportsclubregistration2024.
- Measurable sports such as athletics and swimming shall adopt the qualifying distance, time, and points set by the Palarong Pambansa.(see DepEd Memorandum No.020 s.2024)
- For elementary athlete, the cut-off birthdate is on or after January 1, 2012, and for the secondary athlete, the cut-off birthdate is on or after January 1, 2007.
- 11. Service credits shall be granted to Teachers who will participate in the competitions as coach, assistant coach, chaperone, technical/officiating officials or committee member pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers, while Non-Teaching Personnel shall earn Compensatory Time-Off.
