CONDUCT OF DIVISION TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON THE IPED COMPONENT OF THE MATATAG CURRICULUM AND RESKILLING ON INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE SYSTEMS, PRACTICES AND SPIRITUALITY

1. The Schools Division of Tabuk City, through the Indigenous Peoples Education Program, announces the conduct of the Division Training of Trainers on the IPED Component of the MATATAG Curriculum and Reskilling on Indigenous Knowledge, Systems, Practices, and Spirituality at the Blue Coast Beach Hotel, Sta. Ana Cagayan on December 5-8, 2024.
2. The training workshop has the following objectives:
 - a. To identify the core principles and components of the Indigenous Peoples' Education (IPED) component of the MATATAG Curriculum, recognizing its significance in promoting cultural sensitivity and equity in education.
 - b. To analyze key elements of Indigenous Knowledge Systems, Practices, and Spirituality (IKSPS), exploring their cultural significance and relevance to contemporary educational contexts.
 - c. To develop a personalized action plan for integrating Indigenous perspectives into the curriculum and school practices, incorporating diverse teaching strategies, and community partnerships to support implementation efforts.
 - d. To develop indigenized lesson exemplars and worksheets
3. The participants are required to bring with them their laptop, extension cord, and copies of the MATATAG Curriculum Guide for Grade 7, Grade 4, Grade 1, and Kindergarten. The list of participants is found in enclosure 1 of this memorandum. Attendance in this activity is compulsory so sending proxy is not allowed.



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4. Since December 7 and 8 fall on a Saturday and a Sunday, leave credits will be granted to the non-teaching and teaching related personnel while service credits will be granted to the identified master teachers.
5. The expenses for the meals and snacks, accommodation, and training kits for the participants and management team will be charged against the 2024 IPED PSF while their travelling expenses will be charged against local funds/ School MOOE subject to existing government auditing and accounting rules and regulations.
6. The registration starts at 2:00 PM on December 5, 2024 to be followed by the first meal which is dinner on the same date. The last meal will be lunch on December 8, 2024.
