1. This is to announce the conduct of the Southern Tabuk District 3 Joint BSP/GSP Invitational Camp- o- ree and Encampment to be held at Balawag National High School, Balawag, Tabuk City on March 14-16, 2025 with the theme: **“EMPOWERING THE YOUTH TOWARDS GOOD LEADERSHIP AND VALUES THROUGH SCOUTING”**.
2. The activity aims to:
