SUBMISSION OF DATA FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUMMER PROGRAM

To: All CID personnel
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All others concerned

1. In reference to DepEd Order # 10 s. 2025 entitled “Guidelines for the Implementation of the 2025 Department of Education Summer Programs”, there are 3 possible programs that SDO Tabuk City can implement namely: **Summer Academic Remediation Program (SARP), Summer Literacy Remediation Program (SLRP), and our SDO Reading Intervention Program (TRIP).** Schools with learners who failed in one or two subjects are required to implement the Academic Remediation Program, the 17 identified schools (found in enclosure 1) shall implement the Literacy Remediation Program and schools with learners in Grades 1 and 2 classified as Low and High Emerging in the CRLA result shall implement the Tabuk Reading Intervention Program.
2. Schools implementing the Academic Remediation Program (grade 4 to 12 only) shall submit the following.
- a. Letter request to offer the Summer Academic Program indicating the list of learners to attend the program and the list of teachers available to conduct the remedial classes.
 - b. List of learners, specific subjects and competencies following the template.

3. The identified 17-school implementing Literacy Remediation Program (with Low Emerging outgoing Grade 3 learners) shall submit the list of learners and the teachers to serve. The minimum number of learners per class is 7 and the maximum is 12. Schools shall include learners classified high emerging readers in case the identified low emerging learner is less than 7.

4. The schools with learners in Grades 1 and 2 classified as Low and High Emerging Readers in the CRLA result shall submit the list of learners following the template. The minimum number of learners that a teacher will handle is 7 learners. If schools couldn't meet the minimum number of learners, a combination of Grades 1 and 2 can be done.
