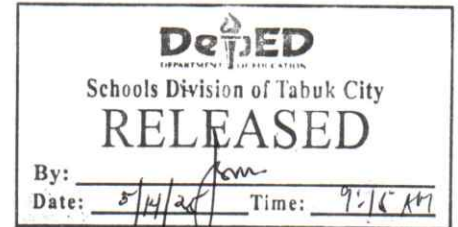

**SDO TABUK CITY DELEGATION TO THE 2025 NATIONAL SCHOOLS  
PRESS CONFERENCE (NSPC)**

To: Public Schools District Supervisors

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No 39, s. 2025 *The 2025 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC)*, this Office releases the List of **SDO Tabuk City Delegation to the 2025 National Schools Press Conference** that will be held on May 18 to 23, 2025 in Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, Region 1.

2. With the theme “Empowering Filipino Youth: Unleashing Potentials in Journalism and Creative Industries in the Era of Artificial Intelligence (AI),” the 2025 NSPC highlights the importance of equipping young Filipinos with the knowledge and skills to excel in Journalism and various domains of creative industries and the role of AI in shaping these fields and the need for the youth to adapt and innovate in this rapidly changing landscape.

2. There will be no registration fee for the 2025 NSPC. Travel expenses of contestants including the *Most Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist* are charged against the downloaded NSPC Funds while coaches shall be charged against the School’s Maintenance and Operating Expenses/Campus Journalism Funds or local funds subject to the usual budgeting and auditing rules and regulations. If the downloaded funds are insufficient to cover expenses, local funds or other alternative sources of funding may be utilized.

3. The billeting school shall be at Santa Central School, Marcos District, Santa, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur. All participants are expected to be at the venue on May 18, 2025. For Radio Script writing and Broadcasting, an orientation will be conducted on May 18, 2025 from 7:00 A.M to 5 P.M. Officials laptops cleared of stored documents shall be submitted to the National Technical Working Group (NTWG). Participants are required to bring 2x2 ID picture which will be attached to the NSPC ID to be provided by the host region. Also, they are required to bring their school ID, parent’s waiver.

4. Non- contestants and parents who are not part of the official regional delegation are required to seek their own accommodation. They must inform the SDOs and ROs earlier of their intent to join the delegation.



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5. Since the activity falls on an EOSY, 7.5-day Vacation Service Credit shall be granted to all participating teacher- coaches who will complete the whole duration. However, for those who will not complete it, one hour of actual service rendered is equivalent to 1.5 hrs of VSC. The granting of VSC is in accordance with DO No.13, s. 2024, Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers.
