- This office through the Curriculum Implementation Division-(CID) informs the conduct of the Division Level Gawad Teodora Alonso (GTA) Story and Poem Writing Contest categorized as Stories for Young Readers by Young Writers on **July 28**, **2025** at the Kagitingan Hall, Schools Division Office.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. recognize the skills and talents of learners in writing authentic literary pieces, and;
 - b. to harvest outputs as entries to the GTA 2025 National Level on August 1, 2025.
- 3. The contest is composed of two (2) categories: a) Kwentong Pambata ng mga Bata, b.) Tulang Pambata ng mga Bata on narratives and learning experiences of learners. One contestant may join in one or in both categories.
- 4. The participants are potential story writers from Grades 4-6 and Grades 7-12 for the elementary and secondary levels respectively to be accompanied by their coaches.
- 5. Stories and poems should be original and written in **FILIPINO**. Contest pieces generated through **artificial intelligence** (AI) will be **rejected**.
- 6. The participants are advised to bring their own laptops for the story and poem writing activity.

Criteria	Factors	Percentage
Concept	Originality and local flavor	20%
Storytelling Style	Artistic presentation, use of literary device (idioms, figures of speech, etc.), appropriate tone of the story, story progression (three-act, framing, etc.), unpredictability, conflict presentation and resolution, utilization of character, effective use of dialog (as needed)	40%
Development of the Theme and Learning Competency	Clarity of the theme, effective presentation, and treatment of learning competencies, appropriateness to grade level	25%
Presentation Standards	Spelling, punctuation, grammar, usage, orthographic compliance, styling	15%

Criteria	Factors	Percentage
Originality and Creativity	Perspectives, ideas, imagery Unique voice and linguistic freshness (avoiding cliches and overused expressions)	20%
Language and Literary Quality	Age-appropriate language Poetic devices	20%
