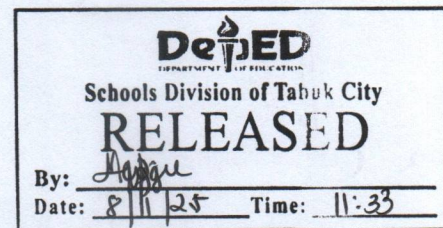

CONDUCT OF SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026 SCHOOL SPORTS PROGRAM

1. In compliance with Executive Order No. 64, s.1993, this office complies to the "Sports for All policy" which requires the Department of Education to provide sports and physical fitness to everyone, regardless of age, gender, ability, or talent, in all organized sports competitions.
2. The activity's goals are to identify learner athletes who are eligible for the higher sports meet and to encourage students to participate in physical activity, collaboration, sportsmanship, and a feeling of community through inclusive and engaging sports programs.
3. In this regard, this Office informs the field of the schedule for various activities in line with the implementation of the School Sports Program, as shown in the table below:


5. Elementary and Secondary Public and Private Schools shall participate in their school intramurals, and other lower sports Meets.



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6. After the Dual and Triangular Meets, all Rank 1 delegation in each sport event in their respective mother districts shall be top seed in each bracket in the Division level.
7. Only schools with an organized sports club shall be eligible to participate from the District Meet to higher levels of competition. Participation is encouraged only in sports events where the school can confidently compete.
8. Measurable sports such as athletics and swimming shall adopt the qualifying distance, time, and points set by the Palarong Pambansa.
9. For elementary athlete, the cut-off birthdate is on or after January 1, 2013, and for the secondary athlete, the cut-off birthdate is on or after January 1, 2008.
10. In adherence to the memorandum issued by the Palarong Pambansa Secretariat on the Conduct of the 2025 Palarong Pambansa Lower Meets, this year's sports meet shall continue to adopt the **Winner-Take-All Policy** for all team sports (Basketball, Softball, Futsal, Sepak Takraw, Baseball) **and the Qualifying Standards** for measurable sports such as Athletics, Swimming, and Archery.
11. Service credits shall be granted to Teachers who will participate in the competitions as coach, assistant coach, chaperone, technical/officiating officials or committee member pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers, while Non-Teaching Personnel shall earn Compensatory Time-Off.
