## CONDUCT OF ELECTION OF DIVISION FEDERATED PTA OFFICERS

 In line with the Department of Education's mandate to strengthen school—community partnerships, and pursuant to existing DepEd Orders on the organization and operations of Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs), the Schools Division of Tabuk City announces the conduct of the Election of Division Federated PTA Officers on November 21, 2025.

In preparation for this division-wide activity, all districts are likewise directed to conduct their Election of District Federated PTA Officers prior to the division election, specifically on November 19–20, 2025, to ensure the timely identification of district representatives.

- 2. The election aims to achieve the following objectives:
  - a. Establish a duly recognized district-level federation of PTA officers that will serve as the coordinating body of all school PTAs within each district;
  - b. Ensure parental representation in decision-making processes at the district and division levels;
  - c. Promote **transparency**, **accountability**, **and integrity** in the implementation of PTA programs, projects, and activities;
  - d. Strengthen collaboration and shared responsibility among parents, teachers, and school officials in support of DepEd programs and initiatives;
  - e. Encourage active and sustained parental involvement in the pursuit of quality, inclusive, and holistic learner development; and
  - f. Identify and officially convene the PTA Presidents from all public elementary and secondary schools in each district as participants and electors during the district-level election.
- Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired to ensure full attendance, preparation, and compliance of all concerned.
