

**PARTICIPANTS TO THE FOUR-WEEK DEAF EDUCATION
 TRAINING PROGRAM**

1. The Department of Education – Cordillera Administrative Region (DepEd-CAR) through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) in partnership with the College of Teacher Education of St. Tonis College Inc. will conduct a Four-Week Deaf Education Training Program scheduled to commence in May 2026 and conclude in June 2026.
2. The training is designed to enhance educator’s knowledge, skills and instructional strategies in Deaf Education. It further aims to equip participants with practical approaches, inclusive teaching methodologies, and deeper understanding of the linguistic, social and educational needs of learners who have hearing impairment (HI) and hard of hearing (HH).
