

**SDO TABUK CITY DELEGATION TO THE 2026 NATIONAL SCHOOLS  
PRESS CONFERENCE (NSPC)**

1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum No 021, s. 2026 *The 2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC)*, this Office releases the List of **SDO Tabuk City Delegation to the 2026 National Schools Press Conference** that will be held on April 13-17, 2026 ( Exclusive of Travel) in Ormoc City, Leyte, Region VIII.

2. With the theme “*Mapanuri, Mapanindigan, at Mapanagutang Pamamahayag (Critical, Principled, and Accountable Journalism)*,” the 2026 NSPC responds to the Department's commitment to foster the holistic development of Filipino learners. It incorporates the 21st-century skills that learners continuously develop as they progress in the basic education program. These standards and skills are manifested in diverse journalistic experiences across print, broadcast, and new media.

3. The SDO Tabuk Delegation is composed of **51** participants, namely: **37 First Place campus journalists in the RSPC**, 11 coaches, the EPS in English, the EPS in Filipino, and the Regional President of the School Paper Advisers Association (Elementary Level). The campus journalists will compete in the following events:

a. Individual Events:

- i. Feature Writing
- ii. Pagsulat ng Lathalain
- iii. Pagwawasto at Pag-Uulo ng Balita
- iv. Pagsulat ng Isports

b. Group Events

- i. Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting
- ii. TV Script Writing and Broadcasting
- iii. Collaborative Desktop Publishing (Elementary and Secondary)
- iv. Online Publishing



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c. The Exhibit of Best Regional School Papers (Top 5 Best School Papers in the RSPC. *(Please refer to Enclosure 1 for the list of official participants to the 2026 National Schools Press Conference)*)

4. There will be **no** registration fee for the 2026 NSPC. Travel expenses of the contestants shall be charged against the downloaded NSPC funds, while expenses for coaches shall be charged against the school's Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Campus Journalism Funds, PTA Funds or other local funds, subject to existing budgeting and auditing rules and regulations. In the event that the downloaded funds are insufficient to cover all expenses, local funds or other alternative funding sources may be utilized.

5. The billeting school shall be at Ipil National High School, Ormoc City, Leyte. All participants are expected to arrive at the venue on or before April 12, 2026, at 1:00 in the afternoon. For the group contests (Radio Script Writing and Broadcasting, TV Script Writing and Broadcasting, Collaborative and Desktop Publishing, and Online Publishing), an orientation shall be conducted on April 12, 2026, from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM at the contest venue. Official laptops, cleared of any stored documents, must be submitted to the National Technical Working Group (NTWG). Participants are required to bring the following:

- a. 2x2 ID picture (to be attached to the NSPC ID to be provided by the host region)
- b. School ID
- c. Parent's waiver
- d. School Form 10 (Learner's Permanent Academic Record)
- e. Medical certificate
- f. Hard copy of the school paper

6. Non-contestants and parents who are not part of the official regional delegation are required to arrange their own accommodation. They must inform their respective SDOs and ROs in advance of their intention to join the delegation.

7. Since the activity falls during the End of School Year (EOSY) break, participating teacher-coaches who complete the entire duration of the activity shall be granted 7.5 days of Vacation Service Credit (VSC). The granting of VSC shall be in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024, or the Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers.
