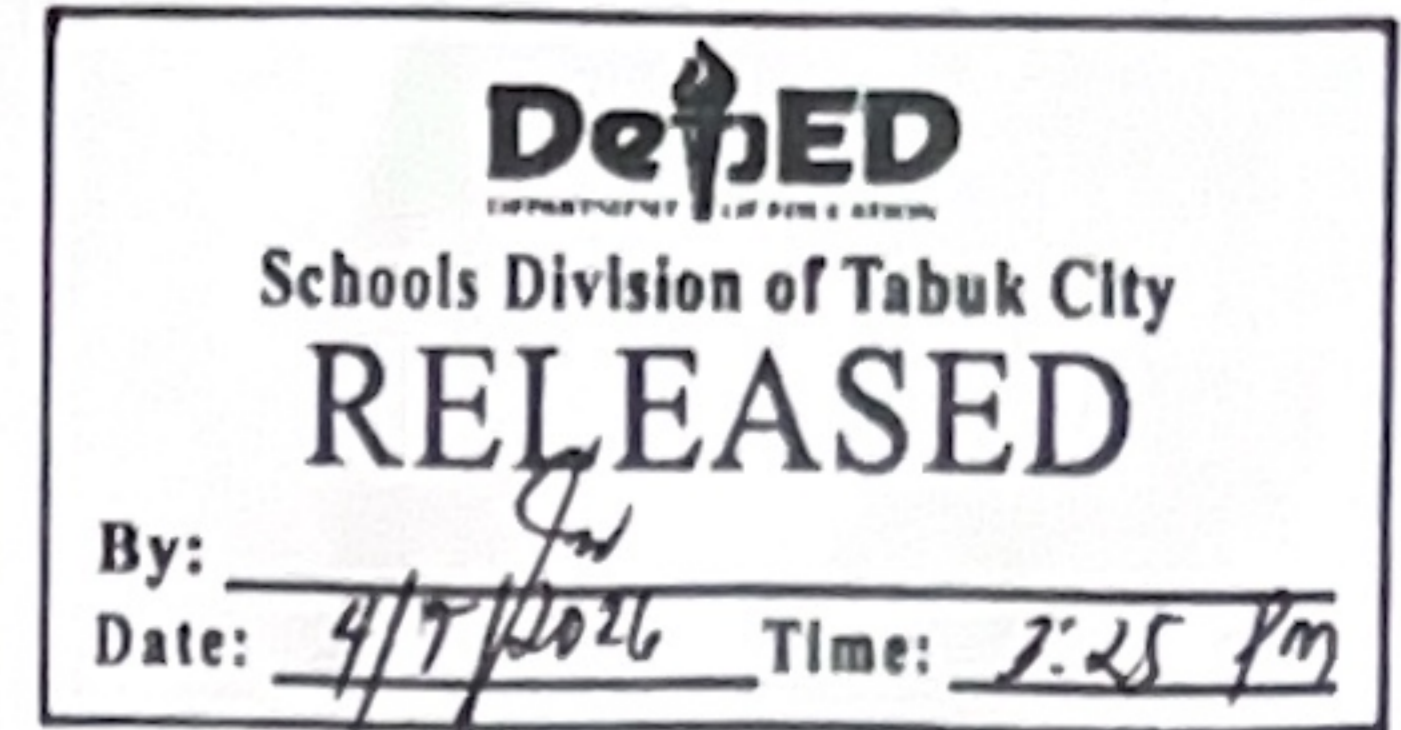

**CONDUCT OF CLINIQUING FOR THE 2026 NATIONAL SCHOOLS
PRESS CONFERENCE (NSPC) COACHES AND CONTESTANTS**

1. As part of the Division's preparation for the 2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct the *Cliniquing For National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) Qualifiers and Coaches* on April 6 to 10, 2026 at the Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) Rooms at the Tabuk City National High School , Dagupan Centro, Tabuk City.
2. Participants are the **Top 1** winning coaches and qualifiers in the Individual Writing Contests English and Filipino elementary and Secondary levels and the Group contests English and Filipino elementary and Secondary. (*Encl 1 contains the list of pax*)
3. Meals and travel expenses of coaches and participants shall be provided by the local funds, School Campus Journalism Funds, PTA funds, or Canteen funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Since the activity falls during the End of School Year (EOSY) break, participating coaches who complete the five (5) day clinic shall be granted 7.5 days of Vacation Service Credit (VSC). The granting of VSC shall be in accordance with DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024, or the Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credit to Teachers.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
