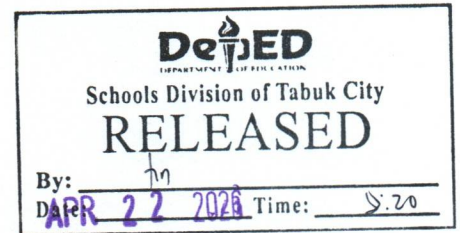

CONDUCT OF LITERACY MAPPING AND ALS ENROLMENT FOR SY 2026-2027

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order no. 001 s 2026, Implementing Guidelines of the Enhanced Alternative Learning System, All ALS Implementers are required to conduct Literacy mapping to identify prospective learners and ALS Advocacy and Social Mobilization to all forty-three (43) barangays in Tabuk City on May 4 to 29, 2026.
2. The objective of the activity is to identify the number of Out-of-School Children, Youths and Adults (OSCYA) who need basic literacy education.
3. All ALS Implementers from the different Community Learning Centers are directed to submit an accomplishment report after the said activity. Teaching and Non-Teaching Participants shall be granted COCs /CTOs or Service Credits subject to existing DepEd and CSC rules and regulations in pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003 and DO 30 s. 2016 – Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Payment in the Department of Education and CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004 on Non-monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered.
4. Travel and other allowable expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Widest dissemination of and compliance with this memorandum is desired.
