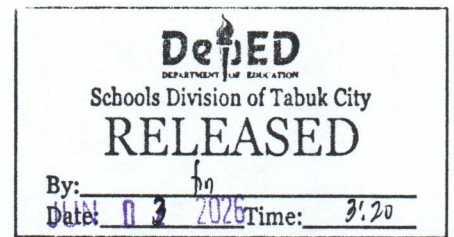

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2026 otherwise known as, the Guidelines on the Implementation of The Three-Term School Calendar, the Schools Division of Tabuk City signify its full support in the said program by adapting concrete steps for its effective implementation.

 3. Conduct learners' height, weight measurements and health check
 4. Conduct systematic learner's profiling
 5. Organize school clubs/class organizations, district and federated PTA organizations
 6. Conduct Pre-assessment activities in CRLA, Phil-IRI And RMA
 7. Preparation of documents in the implementation of 2nd Quarter Programs, Projects and Activities
- C. Suggested activities during the first Instructional Block. 1st Term- June 15- September 1, 2026.
1. An interrupted instructional delivery using modalities focusing on the different competencies intended for each term including Inclusive Programs like IPED, ALS, SNED & Madrassah and Special Programs like in Sports, Arts and Special Science Class in monograde, multi-grade and CLCs
 2. Conduct classroom assessments based from the following parameters;
 - a. Conduct summative tests like written works, performance tasks, Summative Tests & Term Examinations.
 - b. Conduct of SLACs during off-class periods
 - c. Facilitate instructional supervision inside classrooms
 3. Application of Flexible Learning Options as the need arises.
 4. Integration of activities in the lessons in the subject where it is applicable on celebrations and observances.

3. Conduct of LAC sessions focusing on enhancement of academic performance with no class interruptions
4. Embedded remediation activities in ARAL and other activities.
5. Application of Flexible Learning Options when needed
6. Integration of lessons from the DepEd celebrations and Observances
7. In case utilization of any day or days for local fiestas are unavoidable, the day or days shall be replaced during the in-coming End-Of-the Term Block
