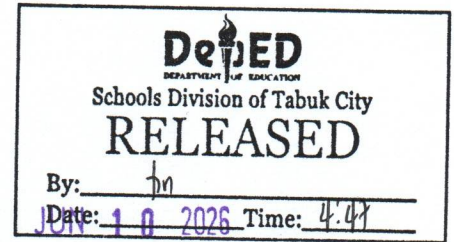

**STRICT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE “NO COLLECTION POLICY” IN ALL
PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF SDO TABUK CITY**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024, directing all Schools Division Offices to establish appropriate monitoring mechanisms and ensure continuing compliance with existing Department issuances, the Schools Division of Tabuk City hereby issues this Memorandum to direct the strict implementation of the “No Collection Policy” in all public schools in the Division during the enrollment period and throughout School Year 2026–2027.
2. Following Republic Act No. 4206, otherwise known as “An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, Colleges and Universities,” as amended by Republic Act No. 5546, the Department of Education (DepEd) issued DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2008, titled “Implementation of No Collection Policy in All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools,” prohibiting the collection of fees and unauthorized contributions from learners during the enrollment period and at any time during the school year.
3. It is further reiterated under Section 1 of RA 4206, as amended by RA 5546, that “the sale of tickets and/or the collection of contributions in any form whatsoever, whether voluntary or otherwise, by any person for any project or purpose from school children, students, and teachers of public and private schools, colleges and universities is hereby prohibited.” Provided, however, that this prohibition shall not cover membership fees of school children and students to the Red Cross, the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, and the Boy Scouts of the Philippines.
4. Section 2 of RA 4206, as amended, provides that non-compliance with the prohibition shall be penalized with a fine or imprisonment for not more than one month, or both, at the discretion of the court.
5. All personnel in the Schools Division of Tabuk City are hereby reminded of DepEd Order No. 49, s. 2022, titled “Amendments to DepEd Order No. 047, s. 2022 (Promotion of Professionalism in the Implementation and Delivery of Basic Education Programs and Services).” This directive likewise serves as a reminder to all DepEd

personnel to refrain from unwarranted solicitations and unauthorized collection of contributions.


6. School Heads shall ensure that all teachers, non-teaching personnel, parents, and stakeholders are properly informed of this policy. Appropriate measures shall likewise be undertaken to prevent any form of coercion, discrimination, or indirect solicitation involving learners and parents.

7. This Memorandum further underscores that all sales of tickets and/or forms of contributions, whether voluntary or otherwise, are prohibited except for the instances provided under RA 4206, as amended. The following membership fees and contributions are not covered by the prohibition, provided that these remain strictly voluntary and are never made a requirement for admission, clearance, participation, or grading:

- a. Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) membership fees
- b. Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) membership fees
- c. Philippine Red Cross membership fees
- d. Anti-TB Fund Drive contributions
- e. Contributions from parents, donors, and stakeholders specifically intended for the support of Barrio High Schools

8. Any violation of this policy shall be dealt with in accordance with existing Civil Service Commission rules, DepEd regulations, and other applicable laws and issuances.

9. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are hereby directed.
