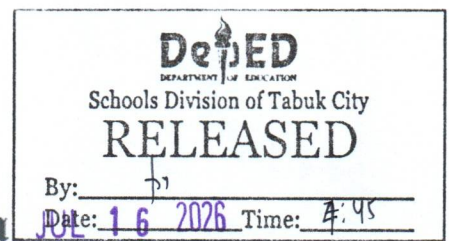

2. The accomplishment of the online form aims to:

- a. Provide the Schools Division Office, Regional Office, and Central Office with reliable and updated information to support decision-making, situational monitoring, and appropriate interventions on class suspensions and other emergency situations;
- b. Centralize the reporting mechanism for monitoring class suspensions due to disasters, emergencies, and other circumstances covered under the Education in Emergencies (EiE) policy; and
- c. Facilitate the development and maintenance of the EiE Dashboard and other related monitoring systems.

3. School Heads shall accomplish the online reporting form only on days when classes are actually suspended. To ensure the accuracy and completeness of data, reports shall cover all class suspensions from June 15, 2026 to the present, and thereafter be accomplished daily for every succeeding day when classes are suspended.

4. The Division Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM)/EiE Focal Persons, with the assistance of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs), shall ensure the compliance of School Heads with this reporting requirement.

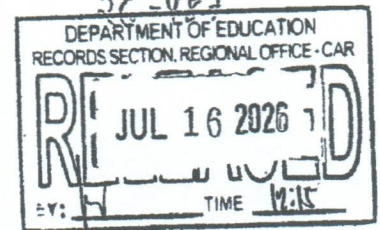

To ensure the accuracy and completeness of data, reports shall cover all class suspensions from June 15, 2026 to the present, then thereafter be accomplished daily for every succeeding day when classes are suspended.
4. SDO ADM Focal Persons, with the assistance of the Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDS), shall ensure the compliance of School Heads with this reporting system until the Central Office fully develops the EiE dashboard.
