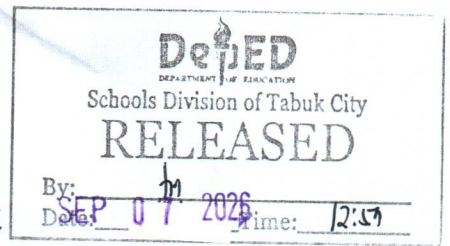

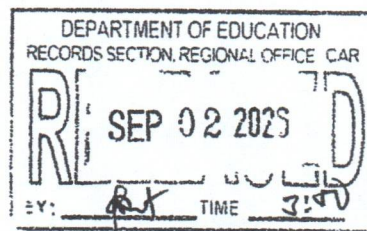

**CONDUCT OF TRAINING FOR ASATIDZ ON CONTENT KNOWLEDGE
AND PEDAGOGY**

1. In relation to Republic Act No. 10533 – *Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013*, which institutionalized the K to 12 Basic Education Program and requires that teachers possess the necessary content knowledge and pedagogical competence to implement the curriculum effectively, DepEd-CAR, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct a **training for Asatidz on September 9-10, 2026, at NEAPR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet.**

2. The activity aims to:
- improve the quality of instruction in Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) through enhanced teacher competence.
 - strengthen curriculum implementation by ensuring newly hired Asatidz and their mentors demonstrate proficiency in delivering standards-based, learner-centered, and inclusive instruction.
 - promote consistent implementation of DepEd policies, and the Madrasah Education Program (MEP) across schools in the Cordillera Administrative Region.

3. Participants shall include the newly hired Asatidz and all Asatidz from the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) of Abra and Benguet. Master Teachers designated to oversee ALIVE teachers are likewise identified to participate, subject to the following allocations:
